The Intel International Science & Engineering Fair (Intel ISEF) is the world's largest pre-college celebration of science. Held annually in May, the Intel ISEF brings together over 1,500 high school students from more than 65 nations to compete for scholarships, tuition grants, internships, scientific field trips and the grand prize, a \$75,000 college scholarship. You'll meet new friends, speak with Nobel Laureates and showcase your research on an international stage.

GET INVOLVED! To be considered for Intel ISEF, you must be registered as a Pittsburgh Regional Science & Engineering Fair participant, submit a Preliminary ISEF Student Application Form along with one copy of your research paper and email your research paper to prsef@carnegiesciencecenter.org by February 10, 2012. Judges review these papers prior to PRSEF. Selected students will be interviewed on Fair Day. Final selection will be determined by a panel of judges at an interview session in the afternoon of Fair Day. Winners will be announced during the Awards Ceremony on Saturday, March 31, 2012. Winners must be available on April 4 for final paperwork submission to ISEF.
