

An Abstract is required for all projects and must be completed following experimentation and submitted by email or entered in the abstract field during online registration on or before February 12, 2010.

Copy the abstract into the body of the email. Do NOT attach the abstract to the email and do NOT email this Abstract Form. Please include Student's Name, Teacher's Name and School in the email.**

**Instructions for completing the Abstract Form:**

After finishing your research and experimentation, you are required to write a 100 word (maximum), one page abstract. The completed abstract form **MUST** be submitted by email or online during the student registration process or before FEBRUARY 12, 2010.

PRSEF special award judges have requested student abstracts for review prior to the competition day.

The abstract should include:

- a) purpose of the experiment
  - b) procedures used
  - c) data
  - d) conclusions
- It may also include any possible research applications.

An abstract should NOT include:

- a) acknowledgements
- b) work or procedures done by the mentor.
